HOME INVASION ROBBERY ARREST

On 04-05-08 at about 4:15am the complainant, W/F 29, who resides at 68XX Ditman Street did hear a knock at her front door. The Complainant answered the door at which time a Hispanic male and a white male forced themselves into the apartment point of gun. The males forced the complainant and her roommate down to the floor demanding money. The males took 3 cell phones, \$130.00 USC, and jewelry.

A short time later 15th District officers observed a black 2001 Oldsmobile being operated by 2 males that fit the description as the males involved in the home invasion. This vehicle fled from police and the marked police vehicles pursued this vehicle to 2500 Tilton Street. Both the Hispanic male and white male ran off on foot. 26th District officers stopped a Hispanic male in the area, this male was positively identified as one of the males who robbed the complainants. The Oldsmobile was stolen from 7700 Temple Road.

Defendant#1: H/M 16 2500 Salmon Street. Charged with Robbery, Burglary, Theft, VUFA, Reckless Endangering Another Person and Assault. ***Juvenile no name or picture **

Defendant #2: W/M 6'1" thin build.
