CARJACKING ARREST

On Friday May 2, 2008, at 4:42 PM, Police received a report of a robbery / carjacking at 600 W. Tusculum St. The complainant stated that one of the offenders pulled a black handgun and pointed it toward him and made a verbal threat. The complainant's 2002 blue Jeep Liberty was taken. During the investigation of the shooting and homicide of Sergeant Stephen Liczbinski, investigators determined that the Jeep recovered during the Homicide investigation, on Saturday 05-03-2008, was the same vehicle reported stolen on Friday at 600 W. Tusculum St. On 05-04-08, at 6:20 PM, police identified and arrested Mitchell Cain 49/B/M, charging him with robbery, carjacking, and related offenses.

Defendant Information: **Mitchell CAIN 49/B/M** of the 200 block of N. 61st Street. Charged with Robbery, Carjacking, Violations of the Uniform Firearms Act, Theft, Possession of an Instrument of Crime, Terroristic Threats, Prohibited Offensive Weapon, and Criminal Conspiracy.
