SHOOTING 15TH & NORRIS STREET

On 05-13-08, at approximately 11:35PM, the complainant 19/B/F, and a friend were at 15th & Norris St., when a male later identified as Marshall **THOMAS**, approached them. **THOMAS** began arguing with the complainant, he then produced a gun and shot the complainant several times. **THOMAS** fled the area on a bike.

The complainant was transported to Temple Hospital by responding Police Officers with gunshot wounds to the chest, leg, and hand. She is currently listed in critical condition.

Marshall **THOMAS** had a previous relationship with the complainant's friend, which appears to be related to the motive in this incident. The offender's escape was captured on Temple Surveillance cameras.

The District Attorney has approved the charges of Attempted Murder, Aggravated Assault, Violations of the Uniform Firearms Act, and related offenses.

Marshall THOMAS 19/M/B, of the 900 block of Brown St is considered armed and dangerous anyone has information regarding these incidents they should call the Philadelphia Police at 9-1-1, TIP line at 215-686-TIPS (8477), or Central Detectives 215-686-3093/4.
